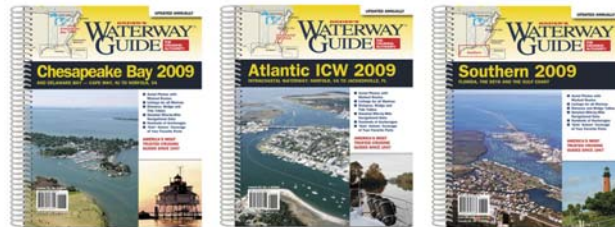

ANNAPOLIS, MD – Oct. 27, 2008 – Dozier’s Waterway Guide, the only cruising guide on the market that is annually updated by experienced on-the-water cruising editors, today announced the release of their 2009 Atlantic ICW, Chesapeake Bay and Southern Waterway Guides.

Continuing their legacy as The Cruising Authority, Waterway Guide has expanded their coverage of the Mid-Atlantic region into two separate guides. The new Chesapeake Bay edition will fast become the indispensable cruising companion for boaters exploring the Chesapeake Bay, the Delaware Bay and the Delmarva Coast from Cape May to Norfolk. The new Atlantic ICW edition takes cruisers along the Intracoastal Waterway from Norfolk, VA, to Jacksonville, FL.

“We are extremely proud of these latest editions” said Publisher Jack Dozier. “The new Chesapeake Bay and Atlantic ICW Waterway Guides not only include significantly expanded coverage, but also feature improved coverage maps with indexed page numbers, expanded Goin’ Ashore articles with town maps highlighting local points of interest, larger and easier to use marina locator charts, and easy-to-reference tide tables and weather station maps.”

The 2009 Southern Waterway Guide features over 500 pages of mile-by-mile navigation information on Florida’s East coast, the St. Johns River, the Okeechobee Waterway, the Keys, Florida’s West coast and the Gulf of Mexico to Brownville, TX. Like all Waterway Guides, it features aerial photography with marked routes, marina listings and locator charts, anchorage information, and “Goin’ Ashore” articles on ports along the way. Helpful cruising data like GPS waypoints, detailed planning maps, distance tables and bridge tables help get cruisers there safely. Flexible spiral binding and heavy laminated covers with bookmarker flaps ensure durability and easy use in the cockpit and at the helm.

The fall launch of the Chesapeake Bay, Atlantic ICW and Southern Guides coincides with the fall migration of cruisers heading south. Two additional 2009 Waterway Guides, the Northern and Great Lakes editions, will be available in February 2009, followed by the new Bahamas Waterway Guide in the spring.

Dozier’s Waterway Guide has been America’s most complete and trusted resource for cruising boaters for over 60 years. Each guide retails for \$39.95.
