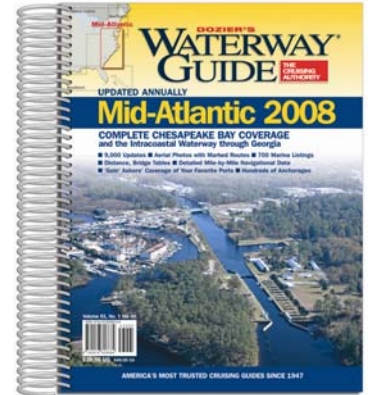

Waterway Guide Releases Mid-Atlantic 2008 Edition

Two additional 2008 **Waterway Guides**, the **Northern** and **Great Lakes** editions, will be out in December.

Each guide retails for \$39.95.
